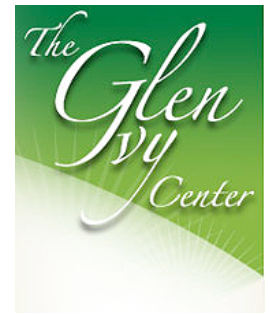

PROGRAM FEE

The fee is \$250.00/U.S. per month for the first three months in the program. Thereafter, there is no charge for the duration of the program. Special arrangements must be made in advance for any child or children you wish to be with you at Glen Ivy during your participation in the program.

Your first payment is due ten (10) days prior to arrival, to be received in The Glen Ivy Center finance office and monthly thereafter on that date.

The FSE Program includes participation in events, trainings and classes offered by EDL,CA including Attunement Classes, The Opening, Stillpoint, Women's/Men's Events.

Programs sponsored by EDL,CA and led by an outside facilitator, are considered OPTIONAL and offered at the same cost as charged to Glen Ivy Community members. Costs will vary.

Sunrise Ranch is the international headquarters of The Emissaries of Divine Light. Certain classes/events held at Sunrise Ranch may be incorporated into your participation in the FSE Program at The Glen Ivy Center at an additional cost to you.

THE PROGRAM

The **FSE PROGRAM** consists of participation in weekly activities including:

- ♦ The Sunday Program that consists of Service, Attunement Circle, Service Conversation, and an afternoon activity.
- ♦ Transformation and Study Groups
- ♦ Mentorship program
- ♦ Community Meetings
- ♦ Attunements
- ♦ Morning Devotions
- ♦ Work in Community Work Activity

There is a work schedule (*approximately 21 hours per week*) involving gardening, kitchen work, homecare, maintenance and landscaping and other. This is designed as a significant component in grounding spiritual theory and as a means of developing a strong sense of selfless service. Participating in the work activities also affords a unique opportunity to develop skill in coordinating and harmonizing with others in offering a potent energetic blessing into the community and the larger world.
